Letter from David Orr

Dear Friends:

This March 20 Gubernatorial Primary generated great interest up and down the ballot, and we saw this result in record-breaking or near-record setting marks in the number of registered voters, voters who took part in the election, the percentage of voters who participated in Early Voting, and the overall turnout rate.

Not only have we reached a record-high number of registered voters in suburban Cook County (1,549,688), the turnout for Early Voting was higher than any other Gubernatorial Primary and nearly as high as the 2016 Presidential Primary, and the number of voters who cast ballots in this election was more than had participated in a Gubernatorial Primary Election in the last 30 years.

This 2018 Gubernatorial Primary Post-Election Report takes a comprehensive look at the voting totals, trends and statistics during the March primary throughout suburban Cook County. Below is a sample size of the standout primary numbers:

- Voting before Election Day – by mail or during early voting and grace period voting – accounted for 29 percent of all ballots cast in this election.
- Early Voting also set a new Gubernatorial Primary record with 109,811 ballots cast in-person before Election Day. That's the highest total yet for a Gubernatorial Primary, and for Primary Elections, second only to the 2016 Presidential Primary (120,681).
- Election Day Registration, offered for the first time in a Gubernatorial Primary, was popular with voters, especially younger ones. Voters between 17 and 22 years old made up 32 percent of the 4,278 who took advantage of Election Day Registration.
- 76.2 percent of all suburban Cook County voters took Democratic ballots – the highest percentage for a Gubernatorial Primary in at least 25 years. Republican ballots were taken by 23.8 percent of voters.
- In the Democratic primary for Governor, J.B. Pritzker got 42 percent of the vote to 28 percent for Daniel Biss and 27 percent for Chris Kennedy. Pritzker got the most votes in 21 of 30 suburban Cook County townships.
- Gov. Bruce Rauner received 54 percent of the vote in suburban Cook County to 46 percent for Jeanne Ives. Rauner got more votes in 21 of the 30 townships.
- There were some close races, but a remarkably close one was the Democratic primary for Cook County Board Commissioner in the 15th District. More than 23,000 votes were cast in this races where Kevin Morrison edged out Ravi Raju by 10 votes.

Third Highest Gubernatorial Primary Turnout In 30 Years


With 29 percent voter turnout, the March 20 Gubernatorial Primary had the highest turnout for a Gubernatorial Primary since 2002 (33.4 percent). The next highest turnout was 30.2 percent in the 1990 Primary – making this year’s contest the third-highest turnout for a Gubernatorial Primary in at least the last 30 years.

The turnout percentage does not necessarily reflect a lack of voter participation, as there were more registered voters in suburban Cook County than ever for the March Primary. Additionally, the number of ballots cast in this election – 450,143 – set a new record for a Gubernatorial Primary. The new record nearly doubled the turnout from the 2014 Gubernatorial Primary.

Record Number of Registered Voters in Suburban Cook County


The 2018 Gubernatorial Primary saw a record number of suburban Cook County registered voters. The 1,549,688 voters are nearly 38,000 more than the previous record of 1,512,190 set in the 2016 Presidential Election and almost 100,000 more than the previous Gubernatorial Primary in 2014.

Historical Turnout by Party

Democratic vs. Republican Ballots in Suburban Cook County 1994-2018



The majority of ballots cast in suburban Cook County have been Democratic in every election since 1994 with the only exceptions coming in 1996 and 2014.

During this year’s primary, 76 percent of all suburban Cook County voters took Democratic ballots – tying 2008 with the highest Democratic share of the vote in recent memory. Meanwhile, 24 percent of voters requested a Republican ballot – nearly a 60 percent decrease from the record high seen in 2014 (55 percent).




Election Day Voter Turnout by Hour

An analysis of the time of the day that voters went to the polls on Election Day shows that turnout started slowly but built throughout the morning before levelling off in the early afternoon. The pace picked up mid-afternoon, leading to the busiest three hours of the day, between 4 – 7 p.m. The busiest one-hour block on Election Day was between 5 – 6 p.m., when more than 37,000 voters cast their ballots at the polls. In comparison to the March 15, 2016 Presidential Primary Election, the voting trends are consistent: voters tend to head to the polls later in the evening with the busiest hour being from 5pm-6pm.

Presidential Primary Election**






Election Day Hourly Voter Turnout by Age

Data from voter check-ins at the polling place shows that generally, older voters tend to vote earlier in the day, whereas the greatest number of young voters were voting near the end of Election Day. Voters between the ages of 68-77 saw their biggest spike between 10-11 a.m. The three most popular hours to vote for those between 48 to 57 years old were all in the last three hours, whereas the three least popular hours to vote for all others were between 6 – 8 a.m. By comparison to the March 15, 2016 Presidential Primary Election, there was a major drop off of Election Day voters from 6-7 a.m. amongst all ages. Voters from age of 17-47 slightly spiked in turnout from 5-6 p.m., whereas in 2016 there was a steady increase in the late hours.

Presidential Primary Election**



Gubernatorial Primary Pre-Election Day Voting Nearly Triples In Every Category

Pre-Election Day voting in all its forms accounted for 29.6 percent of all ballots cast. The 133,086 ballots cast before Election Day – a new Gubernatorial Primary record – was an increase of nearly 210 percent from the 2014 Election. New records were also set in Early Voting, Mail Voting and Grace Period.


With 23,459 mail ballots returned, Mail Voting saw a 183 percent increase from the 8,288 ballots mailed in 2014. Grace Period voting saw its largest increase this election – from 704 ballots in March 2014 to 2,019 ballots in 2018 – a 186.8 percent increase. Early Voting saw an equally significant increase with a record 107,608 voters in the weeks before Election Day – a 216.2 percent increase from the 2014 Gubernatorial Primary.





Democratic Turnout by Township vs. 2014

Democratic turnout at least doubled in all 30 suburban Cook County townships, from 2014 to the 2018 Gubernatorial Primary. Calumet Township had the highest percentage of Democratic ballots cast – 96.6 percent – for the second consecutive Gubernatorial Primary with a 9.9 percentage increase from 2014’s 87.9 percent Democratic turnout.

The biggest increase in Democratic primary ballots cast from 2014 to 2018 was in Barrington Township, which grew by 348.6 percent. The township with highest number of Democratic ballots cast was Thornton with 26,251. Close behind was Proviso Township, with 24,067 ballots cast.

Republican Turnout by Township vs. 2014

All 30 suburban Cook County townships saw a drastic decrease in the percentage of Republican primary ballots cast from 2014 to 2018. Barrington Township had the highest percentage of Republican ballots cast – 50.2 percent – for the second consecutive gubernatorial primary. The biggest drop in Republican primary ballots cast from 2014 to 2018 was in Evanston Township, which fell by -77.6 percent. Close behind was Oak Park Township, with a 76.2 percent drop in Republican ballots cast from 2014 to 2018.

Oak Park had the highest turnout – 44.6 percent, followed by Evanston (42.5 percent) and Riverside (38.4 percent) townships.


A majority of voters overall – 76.4 percent – took Democratic ballots. In 29 townships, a majority of voters took Democratic ballots. Barrington, meanwhile, was the only majority Republican township. Voters in Calumet Township had the highest percentage of Democratic ballots with 96.6 percent of ballots cast.

Rauner Defeats Ives with 54.2% of Suburban Cook County Votes


Governor Bruce Rauner beat challenger Jeanne Ives in 21 of 30 townships. Rauner's highest percentage of the vote, 71.6 percent, came in New Trier township followed by Northfield and Barrington – where he captured 65.4 and 61.7 percent of the vote, respectively. Ives' highest vote percentage, 53 percent, came in Bremen and Berwyn townships. Ives won 9 of 30 townships – all located in the south and west suburbs – by 784 votes, collectively.

Pritzker Wins Crowded Democratic Primary

In a crowded race for Illinois Governor, Democratic voters in suburban Cook County favored businessman JB Pritzker, who won 21 of 30 suburban townships and garnered 42.1 percent of the vote. However, 23 townships actually cast more ballots for the other five candidates combined – 14 of which Pritzker won.


State Senator Daniel Biss captured five Cook County townships and 27.9 percent of ballots while businessman Chris Kennedy won four townships with 26.9 percent of the vote. Candidates Tio Hardiman, Robert Marshall and Bob Daiber took home 3.1 percent of votes.

First Time Candidate Kaegi Defeats County Assessor Berrios



Suburban Cook, Chicago Map Shows 3rd District Vote Split


The Democratic Primary for U.S. Representative in the 3rd Congressional District was one of the closer, not to mention most closely-watched, contests on Election Day.

The 3rd District covers parts of Chicago, suburban Cook County, and Will County. When votes from all those precincts were counted, Incumbent Congressman Daniel Lipinski beat Marie Newman 51.2% to 48.8%. But in suburban Cook County alone, Newman captured 51.7 percent (24,835) of the vote, to Lipinski's 48.3 percent (23,222). Among Chicago voters though, Lipinski picked up a more than 5,000 vote margin of victory – 22,274 votes (56.4 percent) to 17,233 (43.6 percent).

Newman got more votes than Lipinski in five of the eight suburban Cook County townships in the 3rd District. Her best showing was in Lyons Township, where she got 8,920 votes to Lipinski's 6,551. Lipinski did best in Worth Township, where he got 5,974 votes to Newman's 5,137.

The map below shows the winning margin of votes for the candidates in each suburban precinct and 10 city of Chicago wards in the district. Each suburban precinct and Chicago ward in the district is outlined on the map.

On the Republican side, Arthur Jones had no opponent for his party's nomination and he received 13,338 votes from suburban Cook County voters.



Thousands of Write-In Votes Decide MWRD Race

The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) is designed to protect the health and safety of the public in its service area, protect the quality of the water supply source (Lake Michigan), improve the quality of water in watercourses in its service area, protect businesses and homes from flood damages, and manage water as a vital resource for its service area. The District’s service area is 883.5 square miles of Cook County, Illinois. The MWRD is governed by a nine-member board elected at-large with three commissioners elected every two years.

With the passing of Metropolitan Water Reclamation District Commissioner Timothy Bradford with two years remaining on his term, a vacancy opened on the MWRD Board of Commissioners. It was declared that this contest, with the filing deadline having already passed when Commissioner Bradford passed away, would be open to write-in candidates only.*

In this race, a write-in candidate must have received at least as many votes as the number of signatures that would have been required to get on the ballot as a non-write-in candidate. Once reaching that threshold, the person who received the greatest number of write-in votes from the particular party would be the winner of the primary.

The winning Democratic candidate would have to receive at least 8,075 write-in votes, while for the Green Party it was 1,720 write-in votes. If a Republican ran, they would have needed at least 3,206 write-in votes.**

Throughout suburban Cook County, there were 16 official write-in candidates, nearly half of whom were vying for Bradford’s former seat (seven Democrats, one Green Party member).

M. Cameron “Cam” Davis (Democrat), received 28,505 votes in suburban Cook County. The next closest was Simon Gordon (Democrat) with 1,681 write-in votes.

Every Vote Matters: Winners, Losers separated by 2% or Less

Voters are often encouraged to take part in elections with the reminder that “every vote matters,” and in every election there are races that decided by a small number of votes, and your vote could be the one that helps determines an outcome.

This was true in the 2018 Gubernatorial Primary, where five percentage points or less were the difference between a winning and losing candidate.

No race was closer, though, than the Democratic Primary for County Board Commissioner in the northwest suburban 15th County Board District.

Of the 23,502 votes cast in this race, Kevin Morrison came out just ahead of Ravi Raju, 11,756 votes to 11,746, or 50.02 percent to 49.98 percent.

Losing candidates who are within five percent of the winner have 10 days after the election to request a Discovery Recount, a precinct-level canvass of votes.

Reflecting a recent suburban Cook County trend, women outnumbered men among registered and active voters. Women make up 54.3 percent of registered suburban Cook County voters.






Suburban Turnout by Age, Gender and Party

Turnout by Age

Although millennials are now one of the largest segments of the voting-age population, 17-37 year-old voters only accounted for 13.5 percent of the total turnout. Even when expanded to voters under the age of 47, they only made up 25 percent of the vote.

Voters between the ages of 48-77 accounted for nearly 65 percent of the vote – and voters over 47, as a whole, made up 75 percent of the ballots cast in the March 20 Election.



Turnout by Gender and Party

In suburban Cook County, men account for 48.5 percent of the population and women make up 51.5 percent. Election Day data shows that women turned out to vote in the March 20 Primary at higher rates than men – accounting for 54 percent of ballots cast.

Women voters were also the majority in every age group among Democratic voters while men made up the majority in all but two Republican age categories (78-87, 88+).

The highest percentage of Democratic ballots cast were by 17-27 year-old voters (85.7 percent) as opposed to the largest percentage of Republican ballots cast (35.4 percent) by voters over the age of 88.

History

As of January 1, 2014 the “Suffrage at 17” law went into effect. This law extends the right to vote to 17-year-olds across the state which allows them to register and vote in primary elections. The law states that 17 year-olds who will be 18 by the next general election are eligible to vote in the primary election. Since its inception, suburban Cook County has seen an influx of younger voters and is proud to be part of a historical accomplishment that helps the youth engage more in the democratic process.



Voter Interest High in Spotlight Races, Wanes Further Down the Ballot

There's a belief that chief executive races (ex: President, Governor, etc.) drive most voters to turn out. Voters took part in the more notable races, but with a few exceptions, the farther down the ballot voters got, it appears the less interested they became. This, sometimes referred to as "falloff." Below is an analysis of the falloff patterns for the Gubernatorial Primary.

- Gubernatorial: 98.6 percent of Democratic voters cast a ballot for governor. 98.5 percent of voters cast a ballot on the Republican side.
- Generally, Republican falloff was lower than Democratic. There were just 17 contests on the Republican side with more than one candidate, most were at the district level. Some Republican voters saw as few as two contests – Governor and Attorney General.
- There was high participation in the 3rd Congressional District Democratic primary. 96.5 percent of voters cast a ballot for either Daniel Lipinski or Marie Newman. On the Republican side, where Arthur Jones was the only candidate on the ballot, 29.3 percent of voters took a pass on casting their ballot for Jones.
- Democratic State Representative races (contested): Some had very low falloff (4.3% in the 29th District and 5.0% in the 24th District), and some had very high falloff (the 47th District, where 22% of voters didn't make a choice between the two candidates). Overall, most contested state representative races had falloff below 10 percent, meaning 90 percent of people voted for someone.
- Judicial: Lowest falloff was in the 1st Subcircuit (Hambricht vacancy), where 88.9 percent of voters made a selection. But in the 10th Subcircuit (O'Neill Burke vacancy), roughly 25 percent of voters did not vote. Generally, countywide judicial contests averaged about a 20 percent falloff. The Subcircuit median falloff was 17 percent.
- The village of Merrionette Park (428 voters) actually saw a higher rate of choice (99.1%) in their home rule referendum than in the Governor's contests. Only four voters showed up without voting on that question. The remainder of the referenda all saw 92 to 99 percent of voters make selections.

An Online Presence in the Gubernatorial Primary Election

For the second time in a Gubernatorial Primary, voters were able to register to vote and apply for a mail ballot online. The implementation of these initiatives resulted in record-breaking numbers in almost every category.

Aside from a surge in numbers, the Clerk’s online presence also helped Election Day run more efficiently. Online registration, mail ballot applications and the Clerk’s Voter Information Tool increased voter registration and turnout while decreasing lines by allowing eligible residents to register to vote and find their polling place from the comfort of their own home.

- The Clerk’s Election Results page received nearly 26,000 page views on March 20 – nearly equal to the combined total views from the March 15 and November 8, 2016 Presidential Elections (27,172).

- 75 percent of the nearly 31,000 Mail Ballot applications were requested online.




- 112,268 people viewed the Clerk’s Twitter and Facebook pages on Election Day - a 1,580 percent increase from the average 6,681 daily views.

Voter Information Tool Pageviews







Additionally, through community and media outreach, over 2,300 Election Judges who speak additional languages including, Spanish, Hindi, Chinese, Korean and more were hired to work the polls for the Primary Election.






