Dear Voter:

The November 3, 2020 Presidential Election was unprecedented, with the COVID-19 pandemic topping the list of challenges that no one could have imagined. Despite the tremendous obstacles, voters, election judges, and poll workers refused to allow coronavirus to hinder the voting process or suppress their right to vote. With the nation experiencing a resurgence of the virus in the fall months leading up to the election, we urged voters to take advantage of Early Voting and Mail Voting, and they answered that call in historic fashion.

Suburban Cook County voters shattered previous voting records, with the highest level of voter participation recorded over any previous election. Early Voting increased significantly, and voter registration was at an all-time high. And for the first time ever, the Cook County Clerk's Office was exceptionally proud to offer access to the ballot in a total of 12 languages.

In such uncertain times, it was extremely uplifting to be part of a process in which we were able to expand the opportunity to vote before election day, and alleviate barriers so that Cook County residents could have their voices heard at the polls.

Pre-election voting and Election Day itself would not have been possible without the tireless efforts of our election judges, polling place technicians, and the entirety of our elections staff. More than 8,000 of our neighbors answered the call to work at polling places in these challenging times and we could never thank them enough for their service.

This 2020 Presidential General Post-Election Report takes a comprehensive look at voting totals, trends, and statistics for the November General Election in suburban Cook County. Here are some of the headlines:

- Joseph Biden received 781,238 votes from suburban Cook County – the most of any candidate in the county's history.
- 1,188,017 ballots were cast in the 2020 Presidential General Election – the most voter participation in any election ever held in suburban Cook County.
- Out of the 1,188,017 ballots cast in the election, 913,358 – 76 percent – were cast before Election Day, during Early Voting or through Vote by Mail.
- New Trier Township had the highest voter turnout of any township in suburban Cook County with 80.8 percent of registered voters casting ballots.
- Joseph Biden won the vast majority of suburban townships, winning a total of 26 townships compared to Donald Trump's 4 townships.

I hope you find this election report useful and informative. Thank you for your continued support as we strive to ensure that government works for you!

Record Registration and Historic Turnout in 2020


Though the turnout rate for the November 3, 2020 Presidential Election – 71 percent – was about average for Presidential Elections since 1980, the number of ballots cast – 1,188,017 – was an all-time record in suburban Cook County.

The turnout percentage does not necessarily reflect a lack of voter participation, as there were more registered voters in suburban Cook County than ever for this year’s Presidential Election. Additionally, the number of ballots cast in the Presidential Election were about 2.5 times as many as were cast in the March 17, 2020 Presidential Primary.

Pre-Election Day voting breaks records, mail ballot voting sees over 423% increase while Election Day voting sees large drop off

Pre-Election Day voting in all its forms – Early Voting, Mail Voting, and Grace Period Registration and Voting – accounted for 76.9 percent of all ballots cast, an increase of 81 percent from the November 2016 election. Early Voting had a significant increase with a total of 435,413 – over a 20.8 percent increase from the 2016 Presidential Election. A major increase was also seen in Grace Period Voting – from 14,658 ballots in November 2016 to 17,664 ballots this election.


The coronavirus global pandemic spurred the vote by mail public push. The ease and accessibility of requesting a mail ballot and the availability of mail ballot drop boxes in several suburban Cook County locations to return ballots contributed to the four-fold percentage increase in mail ballot utilization. Inversely, the percentage of voters casting votes in person on November 3, 2020, the last possible day to vote in person or at all, dropped by 56.2%.

Voter Turnout by Township

At 80.8 percent, New Trier Township had the highest turnout, returning to the top participation rate for the first time since the November 2004 Election, edging out Oak Park Township which held the position since the November 2008 Election. New Trier has seen over 80% turnout since the last Presidential Election in 2016. Northfield and Lemont Townships saw their highest turnouts since 2004, while Calumet, Bloom, Thornton, Rich and Bremen townships saw their lowest turnout since 1996.



Biden Wins Highest Number of Votes in Modern Suburban Cook County History


Joseph Biden received the highest number of votes – 781,238 – by a presidential candidate in modern suburban Cook County history. The previous record was held by Hillary Clinton, who garnered 699,003 votes in 2016.

While Donald Trump received 377,035 votes – he won more townships (4) than John McCain in the 2008 Presidential Election (3). There were about 2.6 times as many ballots cast this General Election than in the March 17, 2020 Primary Election.

Record Number of Registered Voters in Suburban Cook County

The 2020 Presidential Election had a record number of registered voters. There were 81,000 more registered voters in this year's election than the 2018 General Election record of 1,587,447

Various outreach efforts helped add eligible voters to the rolls, one of which was Election Day Registration. The program allowed 18,508 eligible voters to both register and vote in their home precinct on Election Day.

Biden Wins 87% of Suburban Cook Precincts

Vice President Joseph Biden won 87.1 percent of all suburban Cook County precincts, or 1,393 of 1,599 precincts. Four years ago, then-candidate Hillary Clinton won 88 percent of all suburban Cook County precincts.

Biden often won precincts by wide margins while rarely losing precincts in the same manner. In 588 precincts, at least 70 percent of voters cast ballots for Biden. He failed to win at least 30 percent of the vote in only 1 precinct – Leyden 12 – with 29.2% of the vote.

Biden also won the following 17 precincts by 96 percent or more.

Oak Park 29 at the West Central Church had the largest percentage voter turnout in suburban Cook County with 88.4 percent of registered voters casting ballots. Notably, Evanston had four precincts among those with highest turnout and Thornton had four among the lowest turnout. Thornton Precinct 104 had the lowest voter turnout with 43.6%.



For first time in over a decade, Timber Trail Elementary School had the greatest number of voters cast ballots. Hanover 27 cast 2,693 ballots the most ballots cast in all of Cook County. Hanover surpassed Rich 1 precinct – which held most active precinct in the 2016 and 2012 Presidential Elections – by over 300 ballots cast. In fact, 641 more voters in that precinct participated this election compared to 2016. All top 10 precincts had more than 1,400 voters cast ballots, a difference of 2,890 more votes than the top 10 precincts in the 2016 Presidential Election.

Election Day Registration Numbers Dip Due to COVID-19, Remains Popular with Younger Voters

The November 3 Presidential Election saw a drop off in Election Day Registration (EDR) due to the lack of in person Election Day voting because of the COVID 19 pandemic and stay at home order issued by the Governor. It proved to be very popular with voters who did turnout in person, especially with age group 20 to 29. Of the 18,508 voters who registered and voted on November 3, 31.2 percent were between 20 and 29 years old. The majority of EDR voters were female - women made up 50.7 percent and men made up 49.3 percent of all EDR voters.



An Online Presence in the Presidential Election

Aside from a surge in numbers, the Clerk’s online presence also helped Election Day run more efficiently. Online registration, mail ballot applications and the Clerk’s Voter Information Tool increased voter registration and turnout while decreasing lines by allowing eligible residents to register to vote and find their polling place from the comfort of their own home.

The Clerk’s social media pages also contributed to the successful Presidential Election. Knowing that voters and media alike would need quick access to information and an open dialogue, the Clerk’s office utilized Twitter and Facebook to address questions and monitor voters’ experiences, as well as provide useful updates and information.

Election Day Online Usage

Online Voter Registration

- Over 38,588 eligible suburban Cook County residents registered to vote online in the 90 days leading up to the November 2020 Presidential Election.

Online vs. Paper Mail Ballots

- 67 percent of the nearly 565,000 Mail Ballot Applications were requested online.

Election Day Social Media vs. Average Social Media

- 51,046 people viewed the Clerk’s Twitter page — a 2,512% increase from the average 1,954 daily views.
- 5,479 people viewed the Clerk’s Facebook page — a 1,060% increase from the average 472 daily views.

Voter Information Tool

- More than 87,000 suburban Cook County residents used the Voter Information Tool from November 1-3.
- Informational election videos were viewed 1,238 times by voters between October 13 and November 3.
- An intense election judge recruitment effort up to Election Day was indicated by 9,045 views of pollworker training videos on the night before and on Election Day.


