Dear Friends,

The November 6, 2018 Gubernatorial Election was both significant and historic for many reasons.

First and foremost, voter engagement across all ages and categories was especially impressive. Examples of why it was so much more impressive than prior years included the following, just to list a few: more ballots were cast, more people participated in Early Voting, more 18-34 year-olds voted, more residents registered to vote, and the turnout of all registered voters was higher this election than any previous Gubernatorial Election in suburban Cook County. Below is a snapshot of the kind of specific standout General Election data that is included in this report:

255,797 people voted at one of dozens of in-person early voting locations, which set a record for any previous Gubernatorial Election, and was second only to the 2016 Presidential Election.

95,105 people used mail voting, which surpassed the previous record 87,987 mail ballots received by the Clerk's office for the 2016 Presidential Election.

This 2018 Gubernatorial Post-Election Report provides a comprehensive look at voting information, including raw totals, trends, and overall statistics gleaned from the November General Election throughout suburban Cook County. Here are a few more notable snippets:

- **539,382** – the total number of votes J.B. Pritzker received from suburban Cook County, which is the most of any winning gubernatorial candidate in at least 20 years.
- **5 out of 30** – the number of suburban Cook County townships that incumbent Governor, Bruce Rauner defeated his Democratic challenger, J.B. Pritzker in. Such a performance was a stark contrast from the 2014 gubernatorial election, when then Republican challenger, Bruce Rauner, defeated the incumbent Governor, Pat Quinn, by winning 16 out of the same 30 suburban Cook County townships.
- **72 percent** – Oak Park Township's voter turnout, which was the highest of any township in suburban Cook County.
- **883,457** – the total number of voters who participated in the 2018 Gubernatorial General Election, which surpassed the 2014 Gubernatorial General Election voter total by over 185,000 voters (approximately 697,000 voters voted that election).
- **42 percent** – the percentage of votes which were cast before Election Day, either in-person, or via mail ballot.

Additionally, the 2018 Gubernatorial General Election also featured a key passing of the baton, as to my absolute honor and delight, the voters of Cook County chose me to succeed our former Clerk of 28 years, David Orr. It is both an honor and a privilege to have been chosen by millions of Cook County voters to continue the legacy of professionalism and reform in the guardianship of our birth, death, marriage, election, and soon, our records of home ownership, which tell the stories of our lives.

Such a privilege is not one I take lightly, and I am committed to building on the strong foundation forged by my predecessor. We at the Cook County Clerk's Office will continue to work to attain and maintain the highest levels of confidence in our operations, and community engagement. This Election Report is the result of countless hours of work and analysis by our office, and we hope you find it to be useful and informative. Thank you for your continued support as we continue to ensure that government works for you!

Record Registration and Historic Turnout in 2018


The 1,587,447 registered voters in suburban Cook County represented a 13.5 percent increase over the 1,398,724 registered voters in the 2014 Gubernatorial General Election. The record registration also translated to the highest Gubernatorial turnout since at least 1990 (55.6 percent) with 883,457 ballots cast – a 26.9 percent increase over the 2014 election.

Voter registration efforts by the Clerk’s office as well as civic, education, community and religious groups were instrumental to adding voters to the rolls. Increased participation in pre-election day voting as well as competitive races were crucial to the historic 2018 turnout.

Gubernatorial Election Turnout: 1990-2018



Pre-Election Day Voting Increases 101% from 2014, Accounts for 42.3% of Total Turnout

Pre-Election Day voting in all its forms – in-person Early Voting, Mail Voting, and Grace Period registration and voting – proved extremely popular this election, making up over 42 percent of the total number of ballots cast, an increase of 100.9 percent from the November 2014 Election.


Early Voting was record-breaking, with 255,797 ballots cast. Suburban Cook County also had a new high for Mail Voting in a midterm, with 95,105 ballots cast - a 85.6 percent jump over 2014. Additionally, 23,060 voters took advantage of Grace Period registration to register and vote after the usual deadline but before Election Day.



Turnout Up In All 30 Townships

All 30 suburban Cook County townships saw an increase in turnout percentage and the number of ballots cast – compared to the 2014 Gubernatorial Election when voter turnout fell across each of the 30 suburban townships.

Oak Park had the highest turnout (71.5 percent), overtaking New Trier township—the highest turnout township over the past four gubernatorial elections. Eight townships also topped the 60 percent threshold. As in 2014, 2010 and 2006, Cicero again had the lowest turnout with 42.2 percent of voters casting ballots.





Youth Engagement Surges, Women Voters Continue to Outnumber Men

Along with the record number of registered voters and the number of voters who took part in the election, the other notable characteristic of this election was the engagement of younger voters.

Younger voters (ages 18-34) turned out in higher numbers than ever for a Gubernatorial Election, even while they were outnumbered by voters of their parents' and grandparents' age.

Turnout among voters 18-24 jumped from 3.5 percent of all voters in 2014 to 6.2 percent in 2018. By the numbers, the increase in participation is more dramatic – 25,053 voters ages 18-24 participated in the 2014 Gubernatorial Election. That number nearly doubled in 2018, to 47,430. Participation of younger voters may bode well for the future, but the bulk of voters still are older. More than half of voters in the Gubernatorial Election (51 percent) were over 55 years old. The youngest voters in this election were 18 years old, while the oldest was 107. The average age was 54.

Along gender lines, women typically outnumber men by about 10 percentage points in elections in suburban Cook County. This election was no different, with women making up 55 percent of voters. That's up slightly from 2014, when 54.2 percent (376,251) of voters were women.





Older Voters are Early Birds, Younger Voters Surge to Polls as Closing Time Nears

The Cook County Clerk’s Office has been able to track voter participation not only by voters’ ages, but also by age at each hour on Election Day.

Generally, voter turnout to the polls was strong when polls opened, dipped a bit through the morning, picked up near lunch hour, and dipped again until about 4 p.m., when all age groups except one made a last run to cast their ballots.

As shown in the charts below, after the first hour polls were open, 6 a.m. – 7 a.m., turnout of voters of all ages up to 60 dipped. For voters 60 and over though, their turnout peaked in the 11 a.m. – Noon hour.

Except for those over 60, turnout was at its lowest between noon and 2 p.m., but from that point on turnout built up to the 4 p.m. – 5 p.m. hour, where it was at its highest for all voters under 60.



An Online Presence in the Gubernatorial Election

For the second time in a Gubernatorial General Election, voters were able to register to vote and apply for a mail ballot online. Since their implementation, these initiatives have resulted in increased Pre-Election Day ballots, turnout and record-breaking numbers in almost every category.

Aside from a surge in numbers, the Clerk’s online presence also helped Election Day run more efficiently. Online registration, mail ballot applications and the Clerk’s Voter Information Tool increased voter registration and turnout while decreasing lines by allowing eligible residents to register to vote and find their polling place from the comfort of their own home.

- The Clerk’s Election Results page received 22,471 page views on November 6 – nearly equal to the combined total views from the March 15 and November 8, 2016 Presidential Elections (27,172).

- 36 percent of the more than 95,000 Mail Ballot applications were requested online.


Election Day Social Media vs. Average Social Media

- 61,116 people viewed the Clerk’s Twitter and Facebook pages on Election Day - a 1,122 percent increase from the average 5,000 daily views.

Voter Information Tool

- More than 145,368 suburban Cook County residents used the Voter Information Tool from November 4-6.
- The “Find Your Polling Place” video was watched over 400 times from November 4-6.
- The Clerk’s various Election Judge training videos were viewed over 4,500 times in the month before the November 6 Election.

Snapshots from Election Day



All 498 Ballot styles for the November 6, Gubernatorial Election were offered in several languages. Additionally, through community and media outreach, over 7,300 Election Judges were hired to work the polls for Election Day – many of whom speak additional languages including Spanish, Hindi, Chinese and Korean.



Voters made their voices heard on Election Day with a nearly 56% voter turnout – the highest turnout for a Gubernatorial Election in over a decade. Nearly 884,000 registered voters cast their Gubernatorial ballots in 1,599 suburban polling places on November 6.



Suburban Cook County saw record breaking numbers in voter turnout during the Gubernatorial Election with voters of all ages coming out to cast their vote. With both touchscreen and paper ballots, the Cook County Clerk's office is committed to expanding accessibility to allow voters a private and independent voice at the polls.



With nearly 1,600 precincts in Suburban Cook County, the Clerk's office operates with efficiency to try and reduce any polling place issues. The Clerk's office has more than 120 customer service phone line employees, who took over 4,000 calls providing technical, legal, and procedural support for Election Judges out in the field on Election Day.
