## First Presidential Primary with Election Day Registration, 17 YO voters

Polls open Tuesday 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.

More than 1.4 million suburban Cook County residents – a record number for a presidential election – are registered to vote in tomorrow's Presidential Primary Election, according to Cook County Clerk David Orr.

This is the first Presidential Primary election where recent changes to state law such as Election Day Registration and 17-year-old and voting, will be in effect.

"These changes I've championed for years, to make registration and voting easier, have helped to drive registration and turnout before election day," Orr said. "We've already broken records in early voting and voting by mail in this election. From the presidential races to some countywide and state legislative races, there's a lot that's generating interest and excitement. Elections matter, and primary elections matter especially so."

An updated voter registration card was included in an election information notice mailed to all registered voters last month. Voters are not required to show the card before voting, but it does list useful information including the voter's precinct, polling location and voting districts. Voters can also check their registration status, precinct, polling place and sample ballot at the Clerk's website, <u>cookcountyclerk.com/VoterInfo</u>, or via the Clerk's mobile site, m.cookcountyclerk.com.

Here are some interesting statistics about tomorrow's election:

- 1,443,261 registered voters in suburban Cook County (1,394,649 in the 2012 Presidential Primary)
- 989 candidates in 263 contests, 31% of which are contested
- 8,500 election judges, working in 1,036 polling places
- 102,408 ballots cast during early voting through Sunday, comparable to 37,209 total early votes in 2012
- The five busiest early voting locations through Sunday were: Arlington Heights Village Hall (5,882); Orland Township (5,747); Evanston Civic Center (5,153); Matteson Community Center (5,064); Northbrook Village Hall (4,386).
- 27.8% of early voters have cast Republican ballots (compared with 38.6% of early voters in the 2012 Primary)
- This is the first Presidential Primary in Illinois that 17-year-olds can register and vote if they turn 18 by the November General Election. From Sept. 1, 2015 to Feb. 16, 2016, 5,775 17-year-olds have registered.
- Recent Presidential Primary turnout in suburban Cook County:
  - o **2012: 23.6%**
  - o **2008: 43.3%**
  - o **2004: 31.3%**

#### **ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION**

This is the first Presidential Primary Election to offer Election Day Registration. Voters who are not registered to vote can register and vote at their home precinct **only**, on Election Day. Any voter who is not registered and needs to know where to go to register and vote on Election Day can just go to <u>cookcountyclerk.com/VoterInfo</u> to search by address for their polling place. They need to go to their home precinct to register and vote on Election Day if they are not already registered.

Voters planning on registering to vote or updating their voter information on Election Day must bring two forms of ID, one with current address. No photo ID is necessary.

#### **ELECTION DATA**

<u>Election data</u> including voter registration statistics; turnout history; and Post-Election <u>Reports from previous elections</u> to 2008 are available at the Clerk's website. Maps which show where voters cast specific party ballots throughout Cook County, as well as other election data from the past four elections, can be found in the <u>Map Room</u> section of the Clerk's website.

#### **ELECTION RESULTS**

Election results for suburban Cook County, not including Chicago, will be available at: cookcountyclerk.com.

After polls close on Election Night, the Cook County Clerk's office tabulates and displays unofficial vote totals that include: all early votes; all mail ballots received by Election Day; and all ballots cast in the precincts on Election Day. Precinct- and township-level results are not available on Election Night.

The clerk's office will tabulate all mail ballots received within two weeks of Election Day if they are postmarked by March 15 and all provisional ballots that are verified. By statute, Illinois election authorities have up to three weeks to certify election results.

#### **OVERLAPPING DISTRICTS**

Many district boundaries overlap with another election jurisdiction. In those situations, election night vote totals must be combined from different websites. A handy overlapping district chart is included in the press packet to help guide your coverage.

#### MEDIA CREDENTIALS AND GUIDELINES

Members of the media **do not need a paper credential** provided by the Clerk's office to visit, film or photograph suburban Cook County precincts. However, election judges will require news reporters, photographers and TV crews to show a government-issued or company identification card. Please remember interviews cannot be conducted inside the polling place.

## Media Guidelines for March 15, 2016 Election

### Attention: Reporters, photographers and TV news crews

If any member of the media plans to visit a suburban Cook County polling place on Election Day, please follow these guidelines:

- Upon entering the polling place, introduce yourself to the election judges before conducting any interviews or taking any photographs.
- Provide proof of your media status preferably a press pass with photo. Business cards will also be accepted. (The Clerk's office no longer issues media credentials.)
- All interviews must be conducted outside the polling place, so as not to disturb voting.
- Photos and videos can be taken inside the precinct. However, you may not take shots of a voter making their choices on a paper or touchscreen ballot.
- Please ask first, and respect voters and poll workers who say they do not want to be interviewed or photographed.

The Clerk's office explains these rules to election judges during training. If you encounter resistance, contact Nick Shields, 312.603.6952, or James Scalzitti, 312.603.0991.





# Early Voting Turnout by Voters' Home Precincts Suburban Cook County March 15, 2016 Presidential Primary Election







## 2016 Presidential Primary Election Frequently Asked Questions

#### Q: What hours are polls open on Election Day?

A: Suburban Cook County polling places are open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, March 15.

#### Q: Do I have to go to a specific polling place on Election Day?

A: Yes. Both registered and unregistered residents can find out where their polling place is, as well as view a sample ballot, on the <u>Your Voter Information</u> page on the Clerk's website. You can also see the same information via any smartphone or tablet device, on the Clerk's mobile voter information page, at m.cookcountyclerk.com.

# Q: Can I still register and vote on Election Day if I am not registered to vote, and can I do so at my local polling place?

A: This year, for the first time, Election Day Registration will allow unregistered voters to register and vote on Election Day in every suburban polling place. On Election Day, voters must go to their home precinct in order to participate in Election Day Registration. Residents are encouraged to visit the Clerk's Voter Information page at <u>www.cookcountyclerk.com/VoterInfo</u> to find their home precinct, sample ballot and referenda (if applicable). Any voter who needs to register for the first time or file an address/name change must present two <u>forms of ID</u> – neither needs to be a photo ID, but one must include the voter's current address.

#### Q: Do I have to choose a political party's ballot in order to vote?

A: Yes. In primary elections, you must choose to vote a specific political party ballot.

# Q: Who do I call if there's a problem at my polling place with registration, equipment, electioneering, etc.?

A: To report voter fraud or irregularities, call our legal department, at 312.603.0236.

#### Q. What are the ways to vote in the precincts?

A. Every voter has a choice between a paper or touch screen ballot.

#### Q. What if the wrong candidates or offices are on my ballot?

A. Alert an election judge. Do not make any selections or cast your ballot until the election judge has addressed the issue. Once you cast the ballot, the vote is cast and your ballot cannot be retrieved.

# Q. What if I make a mistake while voting, such as selecting a candidate that I don't want to vote for?

A. If you notice a mistake on your touch screen, just go back to that selection and touch that choice again, then make the choice you want to make. If you are having trouble with the touch screen, alert an election judge. If you make a mistake on a paper ballot, you must ask the election judge for a new paper ballot. Once you have cast the ballot, either paper or touch screen, the vote is cast and cannot be changed.

#### Q. I received a mail ballot at home but did not mail it in. Can I vote at a polling place instead?

A. As long as you did not mail in the ballot, you can vote in person at your local precinct on Election Day. If you vote at the polls on Election Day and your mail ballot is received later by the Clerk's office, it will be destroyed, and only the first vote will be counted. Additionally, remember that it is a felony not just to vote twice in the same election, but to even attempt to vote more than once in the same election.
