# **Primary Election Equipment Setup Guide**

## **Special Ballot Box & Scanner Setup**

for the February 23, 2021 Consolidated Primary Election

For this Election, we will be setting up the Ballot Box, the Touchscreens, the Ballot Printers and the UPS outside of the VSC. The VSC will only be used for Election material and equipment transport.

- $\rightarrow$  Use this checklist when instructed to do so after step 3 on page 27.
  - » This checklist will replace Checklist 3, from pages 28 32, in the Election Judge Manual in February.
- $\rightarrow$  Once the setup is complete, continue on to Checklist 4, on page 33 in the Election Judge Manual.

**Follow** the steps on this checklist to set up the Ballot Box and Scanner for the February Election.

	1	Record the outside seal numbers on the Ballot Box on the Record of Seals.  → (2) Cover seals (both ends)  → (1) Ballot Box door seal
	2	<ul><li>A. Break the seals on the cover.</li><li>B. Place broken seals in Used Seals Plastic Bag 605.</li></ul>
	3	<ul><li>A. Unlock the cover.</li><li>B. Remove the cover and set it aside.</li></ul>
	4	<ul> <li>A. Unwind the cord.</li> <li>B. Route the cord on top of the Ballot Box.</li> <li>C. Secure it to the hook at the bottom of the Ballot Box</li> <li>D. Plug it into a wall outlet or power strip.</li> <li>E. Lock the wheels.</li> <li>F. Tape the cord to the floor if necessary.</li> </ul>
	5	<b>Record</b> the seal number for the Alternate Ballot Box on the Record of Seals.
	6	<ul> <li>A. Break the seal on the Ballot Box door.         → Place the broken seal in Used Seals Plastic Bag 605.     </li> <li>B. Unlock and open the door.</li> <li>C. Verify that the Ballot Box is empty.</li> </ul>
	7	<ul><li>A. Close and lock the door.</li><li>B. Re-seal it with a red seal from New Seals Plastic Bag 603.</li></ul>



## Setting up a Scanner (continued)

## Scanner


Scanner		
Record the seal numbers on the Scanner.  → Administrator Memory Card Door → Poll Worker Memory Card Door → Transmission Door → Printer Door → Latch securing the Scanner to the Ballot Box		
<ul> <li>Make sure you see a flashing orange light on the face of the Scanner.</li> <li>→ The flashing light indicates the Scanner is plugged in and getting power.</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>A. Press the power button.</li> <li>→ Inside the hole on the front left side of the Scanner.</li> <li>→ Use the back of a pen to access the button.</li> <li>B. Hold it for 2-3 seconds.</li> <li>→ The Scanner will emit several beeps.</li> <li>→ 2 lights will appear.</li> <li>» Greenish yellow</li> <li>» Orange</li> </ul>		
The power button is located to the left of the 3 LED lights next to the Administrator Memory Card Door.		
<ul> <li>"Ready" will appear on the screen with the message "Please apply your Security Token to login."</li> <li>A. Press the Security Key to the Security Key receptacle.</li> <li>→ The password screen will appear.</li> <li>B. Remove the key from the receptacle.</li> </ul>

#### **Power Down the Scanner**

- $\rightarrow$  Only if you are setting up <u>BEFORE</u> Election Day.
- $\rightarrow$  Leave the Scanner powered on if you are setting up <u>ON</u> Election Day.



## Setting up a Voting Station (continued)

	4	<ul> <li>A. Lift the table top.</li> <li>B. Place it on the metal tabs.</li> <li>→ So that the pin fits through the tab and the top is securely in place.</li> </ul>
	5	Slide the lock under the table top on both sides to lock the table in place.
	6	Press down on the wheel latches to lock them in place.

#### UPS

1	Place one UPS between the two Voting Booths.  → Two Touchscreens and two Ballot Printers per UPS.	
2	Power up the UPS.  → Press the power button, then press enter.  » On the face of the UPS.	

## **Ballot Printer**

1	Remove the Ballot Printer and power cord from its carrying case.
2	Place the Ballot Printer on the left side of the voting booth table top.  → The Printer should sit next to Touchscreen Power/Printer door.
3	Connect the cable from the Touchscreen Power/Printer door to the Printer.
4	Connect power cord to Ballot Printer.
5	<ul><li>A. Drop the cord through the hole in the table top, closest to the UPS.</li><li>B. Plug the power cord into an outlet in the red area on the back of the UPS.</li></ul>

## Setting up a Voting Station (continued)

	6	Fill the Ballot Printer with paper.  → It holds 150 sheets.
	7	Press the power button on the front of the Ballot Printer to turn it on.

	1	<ul> <li>A. Remove everything from the Touchscreen carrying case.</li> <li>→ Touchscreen in packing Styrofoam.</li> <li>→ ATI</li> <li>→ Headphones</li> <li>→ Power cord.</li> <li>B. Remove the packing material from the Touchscreen.</li> <li>C. Save all packing material to re-pack at the end of Election Day.</li> </ul>
	2	<ul><li>A. Pull out the stand in back of the Touchscreen.</li><li>B. Place the Touchscreen on the right side of the Ballot Printer on the voting booth table top.</li></ul>
	3	A. Record all seals.  → Power/Printer door (lower right)  → Election Data door (upper right)  → Accessories door (upper left)  → Batteries door (lower left)  B. Two Judges, one from each party, must initial the boxes next to the seal numbers
	4	<ul> <li>A. Break the seal on the Power/Printer door.</li> <li>B. Check the connections.</li> <li>→ The Touchscreen power cord and the Printer cable</li> <li>C. Place the broken seal in Used Seals Plastic Bag 605.</li> </ul>

## Setting up a Voting Station (continued)

5	<ul><li>A. Connect the audio cable to ATI.</li><li>B. Place ATI and headphones behind the Touchscreen.</li></ul>
6	<ul><li>A. Connect the power cable to the power adapter.</li><li>B. Drop the cord through the hole in the table top, closest to the UPS.</li><li>C. Plug the power cord into an outlet in the green area on the back of the UPS.</li></ul>
7	<ul> <li>A. Press and release the power button.         <ul> <li>→ The button is located just below the power cord connection inside the Power/Printer door.</li> </ul> </li> <li>B. Re-seal the door with a red seal from New Seals Plastic Bag 603.         <ul> <li>→ Record the seal number on the Record of Seals.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
8	Once you have setup the Touchscreen and the Ballot Printer  A. Open the privacy shield and place it on the table top.  B. Insert the tabs on the privacy shield through the metal slots on the table.

- → If you are setting up ON Election Day, continue on to page 33 in the Election Judge Manual.

#### **Power Down the Voting Equipment**

 $\rightarrow$  Only if you are setting up <u>BEFORE</u> Election Day.

## Power down the Touchscreen. A. Insert the Poll Worker Card, chip facing down, in the slot. **Touchscreen** B. Enter the 8-digit PIN. C. Press "Login". 1 D. Select "Admin Menu." **E.** Touch the power button on the lower right of the screen to turn it off. See page 269 in the Election Judge manual, Touchscreen Troubleshooting -Activation Issues, if the Touchscreen does not read the Poll Worker Card. Power down the Ballot Printer. 2 → **Press** the power button on the front of the Printer. Power down the UPS Setup A. Press the power button on the face of the 3 screen on the UPS. **B.** Press the "Setup/Enter" button.

## **Closing & Packing up the Voting Stations**

For the Voting Booth, Touchscreen, Ballot Printer & UPS

**Follow** the steps on this checklist to close & pack the Voting Stations at the end of Election Day. **Check** the box next to the item as it is completed.

Check	Step#	Task to complete:	
	1	<ul> <li>A. Insert the Pollworker Card into the card slot.</li> <li>→ With the chip facing down.</li> <li>B. Enter the 8-digit PIN.</li> <li>C. Press "Login."</li> </ul>	
	2	<ul> <li>A. Press the power button at the bottom right.</li> <li>B. Press "Yes" to confirm.</li> <li>→ The Touchscreen will power down.</li> </ul>	
	3	<ul><li>A. Unplug the headphones from the ATI Device.</li><li>B. Unplug the cord to the ATI Device.</li></ul>	
	4	<ul><li>A. Unplug the power adapter from the power cord.</li><li>B. Unplug the power cord from the power strip.</li><li>C. Pull the cord up through the hole in the Voting Booth.</li></ul>	
	5	<ul><li>A. Unplug the printer cable from the back of the printer.</li><li>B. Wrap the cords up neatly.</li></ul>	
	6	<ul><li>A. Push in the stand on the back of the Touchscreen.</li><li>B. Lay it flat on a table.</li></ul>	

## Closing & packing up a Voting Stations (continued)

	A. Carefully pack it back into the packaging material you saved from unpacking.
	→ Take care that all of the cords are wrapped neatly and that the packing material secures the Touchscreen.
	B. Pack it all in the Touchscreen carrying case.
7	→ Touchscreen
	→ ATI
	→ Power Cord
	→ Headphones
	C. Place the Touchscreens in their carrying cases back inside the VSC.


#### **Ballot Printers**

1	Press the power button at the top right of the front of the Printer to power it down.
2	<ul><li>A. Unplug the Printer from the power strip.</li><li>B. Pull the cord up through the holes in the Voting Booth.</li><li>C. Unplug the Printer cable from the back of the Printer.</li></ul>
3	<ul> <li>A. Wrap the power cord neatly.</li> <li>B. Place the Ballot Printer and power cord in the Printer Carrying Case.</li> <li>C. Place the Ballot Printers in their carrying cases back inside the VSC.</li> </ul>

## **UPS**

#### Power down the UPS

- **A. Press** the power button on the face of the screen on the UPS.
- **B.** Press the "Setup/Enter" button.
- C. Place the UPS back inside the VSC.



#### Closing & packing up a Voting Stations (continued)

# **Voting Booths** 1 Lift up on the wheel latches to unlock them. 2 Lift the privacy shield off the table. 3 Slide the locks under the table top on both sides to unlock the table top. 4 Lift the table top up to remove the pins from the tabs and lower it toward the floor. Close the legs. 5 6 Hook the Velcro strip at the top. Slide the privacy shield in 7 the strap on the booth.
