To be in Apparent Conformity with Election Law,
these questions must be answered YES:

1

Were the nomination papers filed within the time required by law?

2

Do the nomination papers of a Candidate include
a timely filed Statement of Candidacy?

Is it signed by the candidate?

Is it notarized?

3

Do the nomination papers of a candidate contain a petition sheet
or sheets containing signatures of purportedly qualified electors?

Are there enough signatures and addresses of qualified
electors to meet legal requirements?

Do the Candidate's nomination papers contain a timely filed
Statement of Economic Interest receipt if required by law?

Are the Candidate's petition sheets bound?

Are the Candidate's petition sheets numbered?
